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cancellations

Cancellations must be made 7 days before attendance without charge. Cancellations after that time (or non-attendance) will result in the full fee being charged including any additional expenses (excursion fees).

fees

Our fees before the Child Care Subsidy are deducted are: standard sessions (\$60); incursions (\$69); excursions (\$75). All fees include breakfast, afternoon tea, activities, incursions and possibly excursions (as outlined on the program). There is an additional \$10 booking fee if your child is not booked in before 6pm the business day before. This includes the excursion due to bus availability, booking tickets, etc. There is an additional excursion fee of \$12 Victoria Point Cineplex (popcorn and water)

supervision

Our standard ratio of carers to children is 1:15. For excursions the ratio is 1:8.

nutrition

A nutritious snack is provided for afternoon tea—please let us know if your child has any special dietary requirements. The menu item is served each day with crackers, cheese, natural protein balls and fresh fruits. We encourage families to pack healthy, nutritious morning tea and lunches for their children. Educators are unable to prepare or heat lunches (such as noodles and pasta) for children.

what to bring

Children should bring a wide-brimmed or legionnaires sunhat (we have a strict NO HAT—NO OUTDOOR PLAY policy), and their morning tea, lunch, and water bottle. Children should also wear enclosed shoes. Please ensure that all belongings are labelled clearly. We discourage children from bringing other personal items and we cannot take responsibility for them.
